1 Legal status and nature of the company

Internet Service Providers Association of Bangladesh (ISPAB) is incorporated in Bangladesh as a company limited by guarantee under section 28 of the Companies Act 1994.

The company was formed with the objective to safeguard the interest of all members of the association and work for the betterment of the industry.

2 Significant account policies

a) Basis of preparation

The financial statements of the company is prepared in accordance with historical cost convention under accrual basis of accounting except income. Provision is made for known liabilities.

b) Recognition of property, plant and equipment and depreciation

Property, plant and equipment are stated at their carrying amount in accordance with BAS - 16 "Property, plant and equipment". Full years depreciation has been charged on assets during the year of disposal. Depreciation is charged on all property, plant and equipment on diminishing balance method on the following rates:

Furniture & fixture	20%
Office equipment	20%
Mobile phone	20%

Repair and renewals are charged when incurred.

c) Income recognition

The main source of income are member's subscription and donation. Annual subscription and donation is recognised as income when it is received. Training fees are recognised when it is due.

d) Reporting period

Financial statements of the Association are prepared following the callender year as reporting period consistently.

e) Reporting currency:

Financial statements of the Association is prepared in Bangladeshi taka (BDT).

f) Previous tear figures have been re arranged to conform with current year presentation.

g) Figures in the accounts have been rounded up to the nearest Taka.
